- Farmers grow corn on every continent except Antarctica.

- There are about 800 kernels in 16 rows on each ear of corn.
- The corncob (ear) is actually part of the corn plant's flower.
- The main ingredient in most dry pet food is corn.
- Corn is America's number one field crop. Corn leads all other crops in value and volume of production.
- A pound of corn consists of approximately 1,300 kernels.
- Corn is used to produce fuel alcohol. Fuel alcohol makes gasoline burn cleaner, reducing air pollution, and it doesn't pollute the water.

You are a farmer who owns 491 acres of farmland. Seed corn costs \$20.00 per acre. Fertilizer costs \$27.00 per acre. Fuel and other expenses cost \$15,000.00 each year. Herbicide costs \$62.25 for a 2.5 gallon container which treats 7 acres.

- 1. You have decided to plant corn. How much will it cost for corn seeds to plant all of your farmland?
- 2. Your corn crop is great! You harvest 150 bushels per acre. What is the total number of corn bushels harvested?

3. You decide to sell your corn today. The market is paying \$2.60 per bushel. Calculate how much you will be paid for your corn.

The Corn Plant - Draw lines to match the parts of the corn plant with its definition

- Ear or cob: protected by a husk of tightly wrapped leaves
- Kernels: the plant's seed and the part you eat
- Roots: these go deep into the soil and carry food and water to the corn plant
- Silk: long soft threads at the top of the corn plant
- Stalk: the stem of a corn plant (some kinds of corn have stalks as high as 31ft)
- Tassel: the flower at the top of the plant
